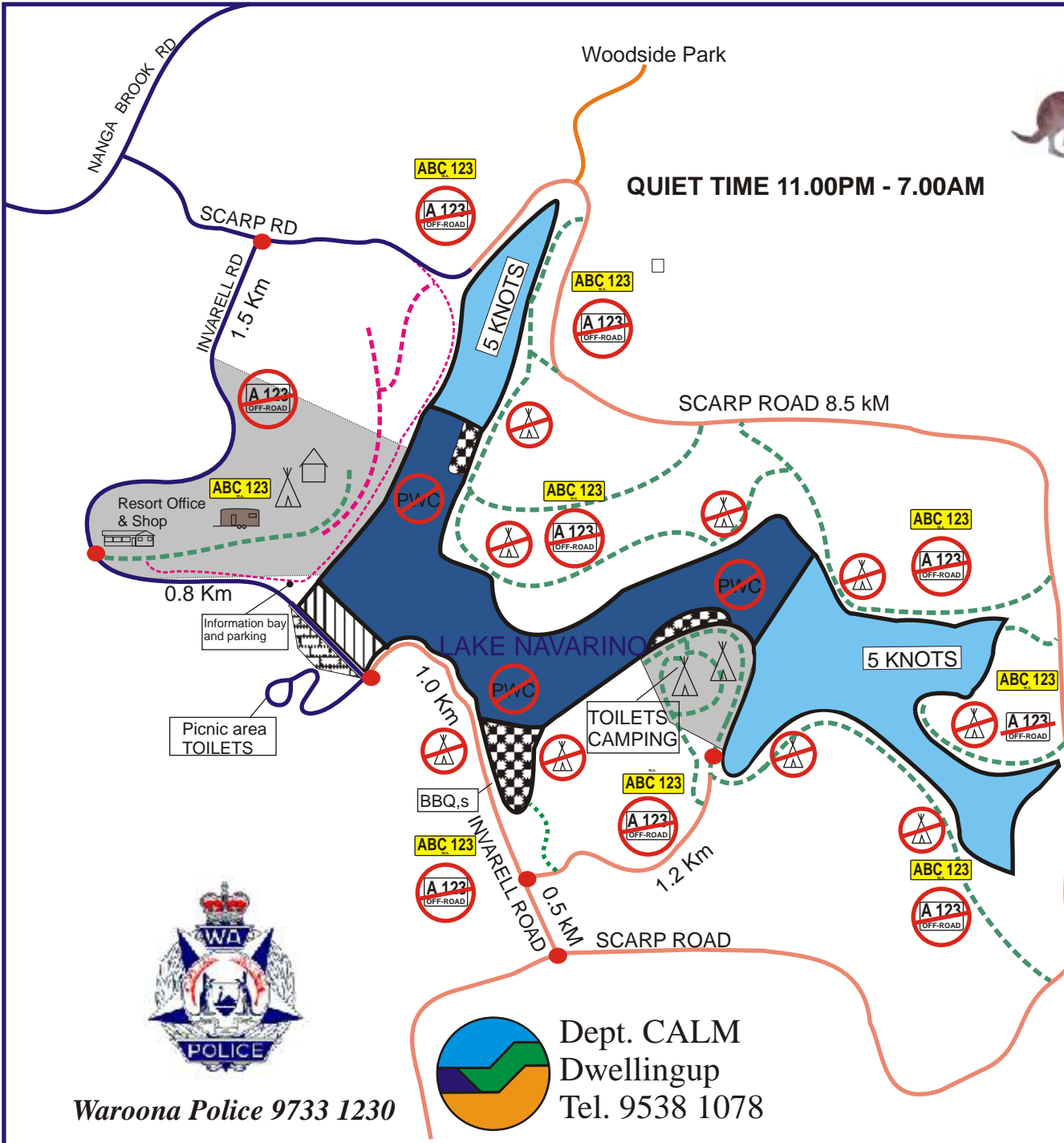

# WELCOME TO WAROONA DAM / LAKE NAVARINO

*We hope your stay will be a happy and safe one. In the interest of safety and protection of the environment here are a few helpful guidelines.*

## **CAMPING**

Camping is only permitted in the gazetted camping area which is marked on the map. If you are unsure of the boundaries of the camping area, ask one of the staff at the Lake Navarino office. Camping fees apply and all camping and camp fires **must be above the lake high water mark.**

## **CAMP FIRES**

Under section 25.1(a) of the Bush Fires Act no camp fires may be lit during the prohibited burning period, usually between the 15th December to the 14th March each year, also when the fire weather is **VERY HIGH OR EXTREME**, there will be a **TOTAL FIRE BAN. NO FIRES** at all except for gas BBQ's. **Severe penalties usually apply for breaches of the Bush Fires Act.**

## **LITTER**

Do not discard empty drink cans, plastic or glass bottles in the camp fire. Place all litter in bags and secure them to prevent spillage. When you pack up to leave, take any remaining litter with you and place it in one of the skip bins provided on your way out or take it home. **DO NOT LEAVE BAGS OF RUBBISH AT YOUR CAMPSITE.** The kangaroos and birds will get into the bags and scatter the contents.

## **QUIET TIME 11.00 pm until 7.00 am**

During quiet time please consider other campers by turning down music and lowering voices. Campers who want an early night should select a campsite away from where there is likely to be noise.

## **SPEED LIMITS (Vehicles)**

Under the Caravan and Camping Ground Regulations, the **mandatory** speed limit in the camping ground is **8 kph**. In all other areas, in the interest of safety and preserving the roads and the environment, please observe the suggested limits.

## **WATER CRAFT**

The lake has been divided up into 3 management areas. The main area of open water is primarily for the purpose of skiing. Anti-clockwise circuits apply as do all other normal skiing regulations. The use of PWC or jet skis is **prohibited** unless it is only used to tow a skier and is carrying an observer who must be at least 14 years old. The other main area of the lake has a restricted speed limit of 5 knots. There must be no skiing in these areas. The third area, between the wall of the dam and a line approximately 200m parallel to it, is prohibited to all water craft.

## **OFF ROAD VEHICLES**

**ALL VEHICLES MUST BE FULLY ROAD LICENSED as per the Road Traffic Act.** There is **no provision** for the recreational use of **ATV's, trail bikes buggies or 4WD's** within the lake catchment area. You may not cross streams or traverse any wetlands. Illegal use of such vehicles may result in eviction from the entire area and prosecution under the Off-Road Vehicles Act. There are various access points around the lake where vehicles may park during the day or launch boats. The use of the foreshore below the high water mark for vehicle access around the lake is prohibited. Access around the reservoir is via Scarp Road and the authorised vehicle tracks marked on the map overleaf.

## **FISHING**

The lake is stocked with Rainbow & Brown trout and Redfin perch. The perch can predominate over other species, hence there is no bag or size limit and you are encouraged not to return any Perch to the lake water. Only artificial lures or fly are to be used, the use of bait or burley is strictly forbidden. When fishing for trout, please observe the trout bag limits (2) and return all unwanted or undersized trout to the water. You can fish any where off the shore except the dam wall. You should also avoid the three ski take off areas when there is boat activity in the area. Fishing from a boat can be done at any time in the two five knot areas. You should not fish from a boat in the open ski area during daylight hours and especially when there are skiers about.

**Fresh Water Recreational Fishing Licenses are required.**

**PLEASE REMEMBER - FISH FOR THE FUTURE**

***Regular patrols by Police, Fisheries Marine, CALM & Water Corporation Catchment Rangers are conducted.***
